Timetable for Shows

- 2-5pm Children will arrive at theatre with their schools for a rehearsal.
- 5-6pm Children have tea (which they bring with them)
- 6pm Doors to the public will open.
- 6.30-8pm Showtime

Children will be safe guarded by their teachers at all times during the event. There is no fee for your school to take part in the project this year.

Tickets will be available to purchase by the children's families and public in cash at the Theatre Royal for £12 or via their online box office for £12 + fees.
